Challenge

To provide a solution for multi-language enterprises to communicate their business process models in foreign languages. To achieve this objective the solution would need the ability to export large volumes of textual based data held within Corporate Modeler's Repository in a format that can be translated, utilizing industry leading translation management software. To complete the task, the translated text would then need to be re-imported back into Corporate Modeler's repository and associated with a "Copy" of the original model and objects, replacing its text with the latest translated version. Thereby, enabling the creation of foreign language versions of business process models to satisfy the local language communication needs of different parts of the enterprise.

Solution

The Multi-Language Manager automatically exports modeling objects into XML or Microsoft Word documents for translation, facilitating either in-house translators or the ability to outsource the translation work to external translation bureaux's that do not require direct access or knowledge of the Corporate Modeler Suite.
